- Dispensation of memorial monies that have been received in memory of Robert Foster was tabled until next month giving more time to gather suggested uses for this gift.
- During the previous discussion, the need for items such as scan, fax, color copy units
  were suggested, however, Eadie recommended that we pursue the possibility of
  upgrading our existing copier contract to accommodate these needs.
